

Language, Literacy and Communication

Share a selection of 'Journey' themed stories, e.g. 'We're going on a bear hunt', 'Leaf man' and 'Stick man'. Use the pictures in the story to talk about what is happening. Join in Harvest songs and songs about Autumn. Mark make our names using big paper and natural paint. Go on a letter hunt and find the letters in your name. Acting out our class story 'We're going on a bear hunt' Drawing and explaining our journey during our Autumn walk. Draw and Mark make our holidays, discuss how we travelled Join in Welsh greeting songs and rhymes. Exploring colour mixing and naming colours in Welsh. Use teddies and characters to greet each other in Welsh. Play dice games to learn instruction words in Welsh.

Maths and Numeracy

Rote counting to 10, forwards and backwards through songs and rhymes. Touch counting objects to 5 and beyond through collecting Autumn treasures. Sorting natural objects that we collect on our Autumn walk. Sorting and identifying animals that hibernate in winter. Creating and copying patterns using leaves/conkers/ pine cones. Identifying objects that are big/ small or medium. Collecting a given number of objects up to 5. Exploring numbers up to 3, matching amounts to the written numeral.

Science and Technology

Journey of a leaf changing colours. Collecting Autumn treasures and identifying them. Understanding Harvest and journey of food from farm to shop. Exploring making bread and changes we observe when making it. Exploring Ice. Using iPads to create a learning journey of our walk around the school. Learning to take photos of observations of Autumn using iPads. Finding the letters of our name on the keyboard. Draw a road for the Beebot to get to school. **Home Learning:** Take pictures of your journey to school and send them to school. What did you see first, next...?

Journeys

Expressive Arts

Print and create patterns using Autumn treasures. Create pictures using leaves to retell our story of leaf man. Explore making Autumn collages using a wide range of materials. Create noises to accompany our class story 'We're going on a bear hunt' Explore sounds using instruments. Use instruments to create the journey of rain from the clouds. Create slow and fast rain drops sounds using instrument falling to the ground.

Humanities

Celebrating a variety of festivals- Harvest, Diwali Create Rangoli patterns and act out the story of Rama and Sita. Exploring our school and the grounds. Looking at places we have around us such as park, church, shops. Share stories about past events and explore old forms of transport and what they look like now. Notice changes and explain differences.

Health and Wellbeing

Yoga sessions exploring how to hold a balance/pose. Share stories focused on emotions and sharing. Look at who is in our family and where we live. Learning to look after our teeth and learning our routine when brushing our teeth. Looking at germs and how they spread- learning how to wash our hands. Learning to use bikes to travel around and create our own journey around the yard. **Home learning-** Bring a picture of your family to show the class.
