## Language, Literacy and Communication

Share a selection of spring and food themed stories, e.g. Oliver's vegetables, Oliver's fruit salad. The Hungry Caterpillar.

Join in spring songs and rhymes.

Recognise and write our names through sensory activities and mark making activities.

Learn and retell parts of our class story 'The Hungry Caterpillar' using puppets and pictures.

Describe foods and what they like to eat.

Begin to learn the first 5 sounds using Read Write Inc through pictures and games such. Talk about what sounds we can hear at the start of words.

Learn some food names in Welsh through songs and rhymes. Talk about the weather in Welsh.

Use counting songs such as un dau tri banana to learn to count in Welsh.

# **Expressive Arts**

Create prints using fruits and vegetables.

Use their collections of Spring natural objects to create collages to show the change of the season.

Explore using colours and water colours to draw their favourite fruits and vegetables.

Learn some traditional dances from festivals such as Luna New Year and Easter.

Use musical instruments to create sounds of Spring and Easter. Explore and listen to music from festivals such as St David's Dav.

**Home Learning-** Create a Spring Collage using things you have collected outside.

### **Maths and Numeracy**

Rote counting to 10, forwards and backwards through songs and rhymes.

Counting collections and matching number numerals to amounts up to 10.

Sorting fruits and vegetables by size.

Comparing length by direct observation.

Making repeating patterns with fruit printing.

Creating and copying patterns using spring objects found outside.

Identifying objects that are big/small or medium. Collecting a given number of objects up to 10.

Begin to use marks or pictures to show how many they have counted.
