

Language, Literacy and Communication

Share a selection of stories exploring locations around the world.

Retell stories orally and write about favourite parts of stories. Create a fact file about ourselves.

Learn our address and visit to the post office to post a letter. Create an advert for our house.

Acrostic poems- Monmouth/Wales.

Eisteddfod competitions.

Read Write Inc. sessions – word time, sounding and blending to read and write words. Begin to hold a sentence and record.

Individual reading sessions – begin reading books when sounding and blending confidently.

Maths and Numeracy

Recite numbers up to 30 forwards and backwards from 20, beginning at different starting points. Read and write numbers to at least 10. Count in 10s to 100 and in 2s to 10. Order numbers to 20 and identify/recall 1 more and 1 less. Count reliably up to 10 objects. Partition 10 objects in different ways to illustrate stories of 10. Introduce the language of early multiplication by grouping. Combine two sets of objects within 10 (including hidden collections). Take away from a hidden collection up to 10 to find how many are left. Use 5p and 1p coins to pay for items up to 10p (anchor on 5). Understand that 10p is the same as 10 pennies. Use standard units of time to read o'clock. Create a simple symmetrical picture. Use direct comparisons with length, height and distance. Use direct comparisons with weight/ mass and capacity.
