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Read and write numbers and number sequences within 30- numbers after/ before and from different starting points. Count in 10s to 100. Order a random set of number cards and say which is the largest/ smallest. Explore stories of 8 and 9. Illustrate bonds of 10- objects/ finger patterns. Recognise domino patterns and focus on doubles. Begin to read numbers. Use the language of early multiplication by grouping. Use the language of early division by sharing. Mentally recall 1more/1 less. Use different combinations of money to pay for items up to 10p. Make a sensible estimate of up to 10 objects. Compare weight and capacity by direct comparison. Move in a given direction (eg: forward, backwards, left, right).
