

Language, Literacy and Communication

Share a selection of jungle stories –Rumble in the Jungle, The Lion Inside, Night Monkey, Day Monkey, I don't want to go to bed! Elmer, Edward in the Jungle, Jungle Jamboree, Monkey Puzzle, Giraffes can't Dance.

Write animal fact files - jungle/rainforest animals.
Write information texts about the jungle. Use 'Look inside Jungles' to assist.

Write a jungle animal book of riddles - what am I?

Plan for a jungle safari trip.

Plan for a jungle themed party, write invitations, write a list of what is needed etc.

Maths and Numeracy

Recite to 30 and beyond, forwards and backwards, & from different starting points.

Count in 10s to 100, forwards and backwards.

Order a random set of number cards. Identify 1 more/less up to 20 and beyond. Count a collection of objects beyond 10. Illustrate number bonds to 10. Recognise domino patterns, focusing on doubles.

Begin to read number words. Use language of early multiplication by grouping and division by sharing.

Combine two sets of objects where both collections are 'hidden' and begin to use the counting on strategy. Take away to find how many are left. Make a sensible estimate of up to 10 objects. Use different combinations of coins to pay for items up to 10p.

Common 2D and 3D shapes. Symmetrical pictures, patterns with 3 objects/colours/numbers.

Science and Technology

Record weather and temperature daily, compare with a chosen jungle location.

Classifying jungle animals - learn about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

Grow plants in our outdoor area, identify basic parts of a plant, learn about what plants need to grow.

Creating shadows, observe how shadows change throughout the day.
