### **Maths and Numeracy**

Read and write numbers and number sequences within 30- numbers after/ before and from different starting points.  
Demonstrate an understanding of place value.  
Partition and recombine pairs of numbers through practical activities.  
Count in 5s and 10s to 100.  
Recognise domino patterns and focus on doubles.  
Using knowledge of doubles and begin to half numbers.  
Begin to read numbers in words.  
Mentally recall 1 more/1 less and onwards.  
Use different combinations of money to pay for items up to 10p.  
Make a sensible estimate of up to 10 objects.  
Create a map and use coordinates to navigate.
