Use counting on strategies to add 2 collections and counting back strategies to mentally solve problems. Add 10 to a single digit number and subtract 10 from a teen number. Make a sensible estimate of a number of objects that can be checked by counting. Pay for items up to 20p anchoring on 10 using different combination of coins. Give change from 10p. Use standard units of time to read o'clock. Recognise and create a symmetrical picture. Use non-standard measures to measure capacity.
