Maths and Numeracy

Recite numbers up to 100, forwards and backwards and from different starting points. Order a sequence of numbers to 30- 1 and 2 more than/less than, number after/before. Position numbers on a 100 bead bar. Compare and order numbers to 20. Bonds of 10. Early multiplication and division. Use counting on strategies to add 2 collections. Use counting back strategies to mentally solve problems. Add 10 to a single digit number and subtract 10 from a teen number. Find totals up to 20p and use different combinations of money to pay. Use non-standard measures to measure length, height, distance, weight, mass. Make lists and tables based on data collected.

Set up a shop at home and practise paying for items up to 20p using a selection of coins.
