Make a list of what you would see in a woodland  
Write instructions for Little Red Riding Hood to get to Grandma's house  
Write a Harvest prayer  
Retell Harvest stories in groups  
Perform a Christmas nativity  
Write a Christmas list for Father Christmas  
Learn names for toys in Welsh  
Read a variety of books in Welsh language in small groups  
Describe animals in Welsh

### **Maths and Numeracy**

Recite number sequences forwards and backwards in 2's, and 10's

- Partition 2 digit numbers
- Read and write numbers to 100
- Doubling and halving using known number facts
- Count sets of objects by grouping
- Solve one step problems involving doubling and halving
- Identify coins and their values and make amounts
- Build multiplication facts using the 2x table
- Order coins up to £1
- Use mental recall of facts to 10 to add/subtract larger numbers

*Homework: Write the 2x and 10x tables and learn them. Look out for numbers to 100 when outside and read them out loud. Practise paying for items up to 50p with coins.*

### **Science and Technology**

Learn how to write a simple code on the laptops

Learn about different plants that grow in different environments

Animal poo – herbivore/carnivore/omnivore

Identify different types of leaves and which trees they come from

How is mud made?

Learn how leaves change and about the different seasons

Label parts of a plant/grow plants and vegetables

Bug hunts – classifications/identification

*Homework: Choose a woodland animal and write a fact file for it. Use a computer to find a photograph.*

Look at animals and match them to their young  
Research nocturnal and diurnal animals

*Homework: Draw a map of your garden and include a key.*
