Maths and Numeracy

Recite number sequences forwards and backwards in 2's, and 10's
-Partition 2 digit numbers
-Read and write numbers to 100
-Doubling and halving using known number facts
- Count sets of objects by grouping
- Solve one step problems involving doubling and halving
- Identify coins and their values and make amounts
- Build multiplication facts using the 2x table
- Order coins up to £1
- Use mental recall of facts to 10 to add/subtract larger numbers
Homework: set up a shop using items from around your house. Practice paying for items with different coins.

Science and Technology

Learn how to write a simple code on the laptops
Use the laptops to develop word processing skills
Learn about different plants that grow in different environments
Identify different types of leaves and which trees they come from
Learn how leaves change and about the different seasons
Label parts of a plant/grow plants and vegetables
Homework: practice typing on a device at home. Can you type your full name including capital letters in the correct places?

Expressive Arts

Learn celebratory dances/music
Use instruments to create music for celebrations
Sing a range of Harvest songs
Make artwork from nature/printing
Sing a range of Christmas songs and perform a nativity
Create cards to send home
Make firework pictures
Use a variety of materials to create still life drawings of harvest foods
Homework: create a piece of art showing a celebration you've attended.

Humanities

Learn about celebrations for New Year around the world and for different religions including Rosh Hashana and Lunar New Year.
Learn about the origins of Bonfire Night
Why do we celebrate remembrance?
Write our own harvest prayer
Collect food for a food bank to help our community.
Homework: ask someone in your family about their experiences of new year. Tell your class about them.
