Developed with parents, carers and professionals from across education, health and social care, including input from local authorities, it responds directly to what parents and carers have told us that information about the ALN system needs to be clearer, simpler and more consistent. It explains how the system works and where support is available for children, young people and families.

All resources are available in English and Welsh, with accessible versions including Easy Read. Together, they are designed to be used as a **national resource** for parents, carers and professionals.

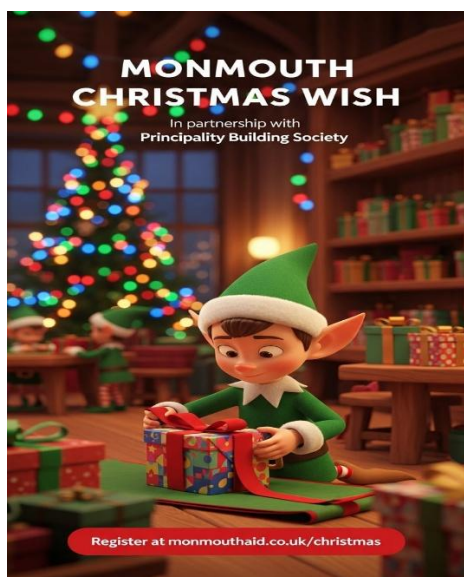

Santa Fun Run – 7th December 2025

Monmouth Santa Fun Run 2025

The event starts at 10.00 am and follows a course of 1.5km, starting at the Monnow Bridge and finishing on Monmouth Sports Ground.

Gather at the bridge where registration will take place between 8.45 and 9.45 am. Entry costs £8 adult, £4 under 16, £22 family, cash only, and all entry fees will be donated to this year's charity, Bridges Quest Busters project, which provides fun activities for children with additional needs. All participants will receive a

medal and a sweet treat. Hot drinks and mince pies will be on sale at the Sports Pavilion in aid of Monmouth Football Club.
