## PE Kits

Please can I remind Parents/carers on the policy for PE kits...

Children are asked to come into school on the PE day/s already in their PE kit.

PE Kit should be dark shorts/joggers and a PE t-shirt of your child's house colour, – this does not have to be with a logo - with daps/trainers.

In the colder months children can wear their school sweatshirt/cardigan – **not hoodies or other sweatshirts.**

The variance in PE has become very stark, particularly in the older years. Wearing the appropriate kit is a good habit to get into in readiness for secondary school, where children are not permitted to wear alternative uniform without consequence.

If you have difficulty in providing suitable kit, please see you child's class teacher as we have plenty of spare uniform needing a new home
